WEEPING with the BROL

Midst a culture of unshed tears

Brother Lester Miller and I had the privilege of teaching four Bondage to Freedom (BTF) and leadership seminars during our August Uganda mission. Forms of rejection such as verbal, physical, and sexual abuse are not commonly addressed in that culture. Twenty-nine pastors were among the 180 attendees at a remote village BTF Seminar. Their plea was "Please bring this teaching to our villages, this teaching is not so familiar to us." Bishop Lubinga Dickson said, "We witnessed the power of God stripping the roots of rejection: this great Monster that has kept many people miserable, captive, and in bondage."

The May mission team partnered with our Ugandan brothers and sisters in prison ministry, refugee camps, medical clinics, construction projects, and children's hospital visitation. The greatest blessing was seeing hundreds of the medical clinic attendees and many

Rarely have we seen such brokenness and anguish of the soul as repentant souls were delivered from the roots of bitterness, anger and unforgiveness. We wept with those who were weeping until bondage gave way to freedom and the joy of Jesus broke forth into glorious praise!

of the 2,000 prisoners pray to receive Jesus Christ. A number of refugee camp converts are 1st generation Christians. Numerous new converts and 1,400 school students (many Muslims) have been given Bibles during the 2015 mission trips.

One of the greatest needs is caring for physically and emotionally challenged children from the refugee camps. We renovated a few rooms to care for eight children and hope to build a more suitable Compassion House in 2016.

The Ugandan Pastors and many fellow believers have expressed sincere appreciation for the Americans who pray and contribute to make available these seminars, Bibles, blankets, medicine, soap, clothes, toys, dolls and toothbrushes. As a ministry, we consider it a privilege to be your hands and heart extended "unto the


We experienced the Spirit drawing people, from a young child asking "Jesus into his heart" to a lady dealing with demonic activities in her life.
