

What great joy to witness the power of God unto salvation! More than 500 men and women prayed to receive Jesus Christ during the combined medical clinic, Pygmies village crusade, and the Bondage to Freedom Seminar. The most heart-touching moment (20 minutes) was seeing over 200 people walk humbly and broken down the center aisle of the tents and push their note (a written witness of what they had just prayed/confessed/surrendered) onto one of the 6 nails on our little wooden cross.

Lester Miller & I expected perhaps 175 leaders and lay people to attend the Bondage to Freedom & Leadership Seminar, but to our amazement there were 360 people the first day and 410 the second day. The

spiritual hunger was genuine and so was the spirit of brokenness and repentance. Uganda is a place of unshed tears and unspoken pain. Various forms of ridicule and abuse have caused deep wounds of rejection and many broken relationships. One pastor handed me a note which said, "Pray for me. My heart was broken for different things that offended me by different people, some of them my superiors in the ministry; I am really depressed." There are many pastors asking for this life-giving seminar to be taught in their villages. Please pray for teachers and resources to meet this need.

UGANDA

God's holy anointing fell as my friend Emmanuel, from Ghana, Africa, preached Jesus and several hundred Pygmies stepped forward to be born again!! Brokenness prevailed - a sight rarely seen in this culture. They are known as "the bush people", surviving very primitively off land they don't own. Following the evangelistic mission, we were able to satisfy their plea for food by giving beans, cooking oil, and flour, along with some blankets. This village needs leadership, a church structure, and a school for these lovely, needy children. ~ *Nelson Coblentz*

Numerous pastors are pleading for Bibles for their church members and now, even predominately Muslim schools are requesting Bibles for their students.
