A Father's Persistent Cry

"I never gave up on my son"


This is a condensed testimony of a father and son, both incarcerated in Colorado prisons.

Dear Miller Family,

I've been a disciple and follower of Christ and have been praying for my son for the 15 years that I have been locked up. Chaplain Matt (Overholt) can tell you how long I've poured my heart out to the Lord.

On October 16, 2017, I requested my son to be moved from his prison to where I was. The Warden denied my request and said, "I am sympathetic to your concerns (but it) is my decision to allow the classification process to work as intended and not intercede. (Since then), God has called me to serve others by preaching the gospel and winning souls. I never gave up on my son.

On March 17, 2019, I told the church, "You all will be witnesses to God bringing my son here." I prayed that God would open doors that no man can shut. Every Sunday after that I told them, "My son is on his way, my son is on his way!" (In May,) the warden denied my request for the last time. (Shortly thereafter) the chapel clerks put the sign-up sheet out for the "Miller Family Musical Concert."

I was the "first" one to sign up and there were 74 slots. I came back a day later (in faith) to sign my son up into slot #72.

On June 5th I received the memo from the "Intel Officer" that my son has been approved to come to the prison where I am! My son came behind the walls of (this) prison on June 14, and that very night he came to the Miller Family service with me. From the beginning, I was calling on the name of our Lord God to pierce my son's heart and conscience, through the message you preached and the awesome songs of worship you sang. When you did the altar call, I told God in my heart, "Do it now, Lord." I was praying my heart out with tears streaming down my cheeks. Then, as I was secretly looking at my son's feet from the corner of my eye, I saw my son take off running to the altar... and I chased after him!... crying, praising, and worshipping God!

That was the happiest day of my life. My dreams, my hopes, and my prayers had come true. God heard me and He saved my son. On July 28th, my son is sealing the deal and making his vow and commitment to Jesus and God in baptism. I am so blessed, honored, and pleased to help baptize him with Chaplain Matt.

Thank you for being God's vessel. May God continue to anoint your family and bless you all with His love, grace, mercy, forgiveness, favor, guidance, provision, and protection.

UGAND **Restoring HOPE to the Hopeless**

We gave medicine to over 1,200 villagers at the 2-day clinic. Many received Christ as we preached during the day. Pastor Billy commented, "The team from America and Canada was thirsty



to reach out and evangelize. They did it without fear in the villages and at the medical clinics.

Even Muslims and Catholics repented as the mission team ministered on the streets at night. Some have now been baptized."

Following a remote village medical clinic, Pastor Ben said, "You have taught us how to love. God is transforming our lives and the whole community. This mission has restored hope to the hopeless, and even unbelievers are calling 'our' church 'their' church." What a privilege preaching the Gospel to over 1,000 high school students and seeing many pray to receive Christ. ers couldn't bathe for several weeks and drinking water had been rationed. When the Word of God was preached at the generator dedication service, 18 prisoners received Jesus Christ! After the service, those 18, along with the prison officials, were each given a new Bible. PTL!






RV Fundraiser

of the greatest God-filled tours our family has experienced. (See front page testimony also.)




