"Nelson, we found this sixteen-year-old girl named Lydia¹ laying on a patch-of grass beside the road near a gas station. It appears she was abandoned and left to die. We picked her up and took her to Nurse Richard's clinic. She was extremely malnourished and had open sores to the bone on her legs and hips, like I had never seen before. Her back was broken and she was paralyzed from the waist down."

When Gary's were telling me the story, I thought of the Good Samaritan that Jesus spoke of in Luke 10. God has given Gary and Rosa a huge heart of love and compassion and also connected them with numerous doctors and hospital administrators. Through these relationships, we have seen a noticeable reduction in surgical fees, PTL!

We have been inundated with medical cases in Uganda, Nigeria, and Ghana, Africa, many of which are quite severe. After observing some of the responses from recent medical cases, Kaylene Mullet (International Secretary) said, "It's literally changing their world!"

She was referring to people like Yusef². It took four surgeons ten hours to remove the large tumor from his neck. Rosa said, "This man's demeanor has totally changed and now we are praying that he would come to believe in the one true God, the Lord Jesus Christ!" Over and over again, we have seen God use acts of compassion to draw the unsaved into a loving relationship with Jesus Christ.

Donors at our Florida auction made it possible for five-year-old Veronica³ to be flown from Ghana, Africa to India for a very, very delicate heart operation. She is doing well and this will "change her world!"

From Life-threatening to life-changing

Twelve-year-old Kato¹ has cerebral palsy. His mother could not carry him and would lock him into the house when she went away. Now, Kato has a wheelchair and receives special care. Gary said, "Kato lifted his hands, laughed, and rejoiced when we put him in the wheelchair." Also in Uganda, we found a man, named Sunday, in a dark shack and uncared for. He was paralyzed from the waist down. After three months of clinical care, he has a new wheelchair, a new shelter with a ramp, and a sewing business. Yes, "it's literally changed his world!"

In February, donors enabled 31 prisoners in Nigeria to have hernia and tumor-related surgeries. Chaplain Nsibiet said, "Some of these were life-threatening. Now, they're life-changing." Also in Nigeria, villagers were suffering from drinking, cooking, and bathing in contaminated water. They came rushing with containers in hand, celebrating the flow of clean water via a new well! This will change an entire village! Presently, we have requests for nine wells/boreholes in Uganda and three in Nigeria. Hand pump wells cost \$3,500 and generator or solar-powered wells, approximately \$11,000.

Thank you so kindly, friend, for opening your bowels of compassion and partnering with us in ministry unto the least of these.

Please pray for Gary and Rosa Miller, as they start their 2nd year, establish a Gospel Express office/headquarters, and finalize our NGO in Uganda. Words cannot explain the great blessing they have been in connecting us in a greater way with pastors, doctors, and nurses in kingdom-building ministry.
