Through the years, ministry donors have sponsored hundreds of medical cases in Uganda, Kenya, and Ghana, Africa. Having staff on the ground in Uganda has established a vital link between Gospel Express and doctors and medical facilities. Through this link and generous donors, we are now able to process more medical cases than ever before. On September 14, some of these sponsored patients and family members were invited to Haven Retreat Center for a celebration of life... and to enjoy a LOVE FEAST based on the principle Jesus shared in Luke 14.

A 9-course meal was served to 42 adults and 8 children and included a rare treat of cake and ice cream.

Each patient also received a blanket, mosquito net, and a food parcel. I had the opportunity to meet and interact with patients and families whom I'd not met before.

Our team from America listened with tear-filled eyes as they took turns to share their stories. For many of them, hope had been lost due to the high cost of surgery. Some had to be done in India. Simon Peter, father of 1-year-old Samson, tearfully said, "The Indian doctors said our baby cannot live through the surgery unless we pray to our God for help. So now you see, I am holding him here today." God had so

Only heaven has recorded the number of souls that came to Christ during the preaching as the clinic was in progress. However, we as pastors have record of 86 people coming to Christ at the clinic prayer tent in the slum area plus 84 becoming born-again at the Amazing Grace School clinic prayer room, including 2 witch doctors! These 2 doctors have been terrorizing the village for a long time, but not anymore! We also saw some strong Muslims come to Jesus,

We had a gallant team of pastors who gave their all in the prayer room.

The gospel ministered on that day birthed a new church called, "Amazing Grace Prayer Center Church." Forty people came to church on the first Sunday and thirty of those people were 'born-agains' from the medical clinic on Tuesday. 
