Medical Clinics

A MINISTRY OF REDEMPTION

Our latest mission in Uganda was among the most challenging and heartbreaking yet. Approximately 2,400 people were treated in three clinics. The Karamoja clinic was a remote refugee camp. A large number of the 300 families had been exiled from their country due to war. Many had watched family members being put to death with machetes in Rwanda... so they fled in order to survive. Lewi Stoll provided excellent leadership in utilizing the giftings of the 30-member US & International team. **It was a humbling task to partner together to "raise the poor out of the dust and lift the needy out of the ash heap ((PS 113:7). Glory to God!... and I trust you will be challenged by reading these glory stories.**


These clinics have become unforgettable moments in my life that I must tell others.
